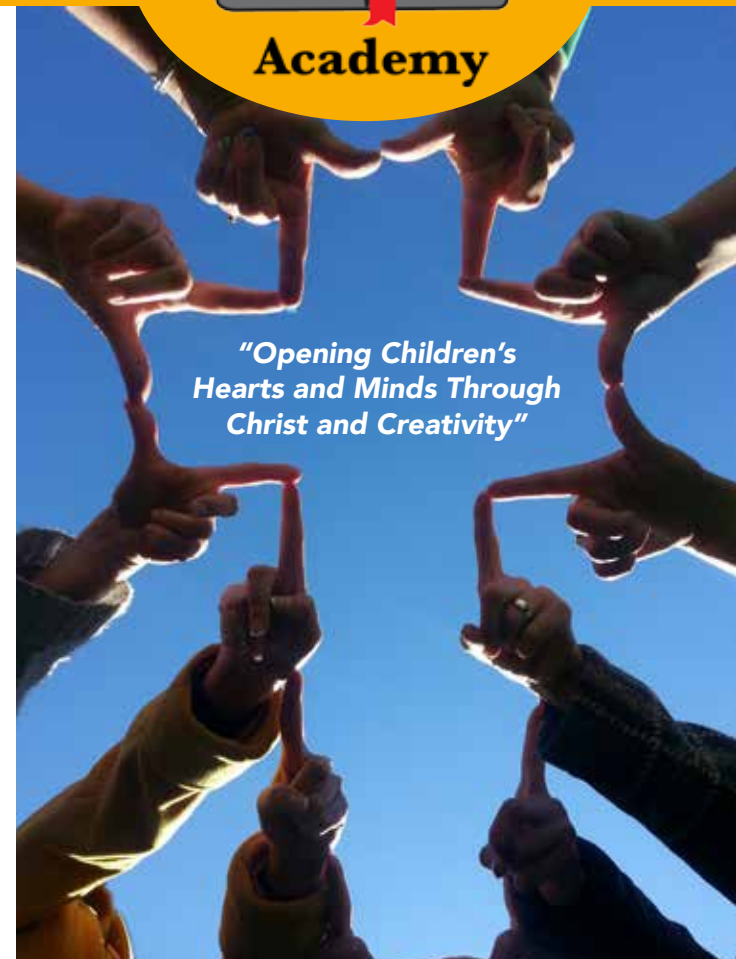

## LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Educational activities that promote early reading and writing skills to prepare children for the next developmental age level.

Our "Handwriting without Tears" curriculum, along with hands-on activities makes learning more enjoyable.

Weekly themes such as Fire Safety, Health & Nutrition, and Farm Animals are incorporated along with letters, numbers, shapes, colors and bible stories.

All lead teachers have earned or are working towards their CDA, AA or BA in Early Childhood Education.

Classrooms are set up into learning centers: Science, Math, Art, Dramatic Play, Manipulatives, Sensory, Writing, Computer and Blocks.

Various activities are offered to promote the development of reading, writing, math and science skills, self-esteem, independence, socialization, cognitive skills, creativity, fine and gross motor skills in order to achieve at least one year of grade level ahead.

Daily Bible stories, devotions, prayer and Weekly Chapel to instill in the children to be kind to others and help others not as fortunate as we are.

Our Pre-K/Junior Kindergarten classes combine weekly themes, letter, number, color, shape and bible verse for the week.

Afternoon Specials include: Sign Language, Spanish, Literature, Music & Movement, Science and Health.
